



STOP Violence Against Women Formula Grant Funds (VAWA)

If a subrecipient receives [STOP Violence Against Women Funds \(VAWA\)](#) funds, an annual STOP VAWA report is due February 15. The reporting period is the previous calendar year (January to December). The STOP VAWA annual report is completed and submitted in the required Adobe file format and uploaded in the Performance Reports component of [Iowa GVS](#).
