CONSENT JUDGMENT

The Court, having been presented by Assistant Attorney General Steve St. Clair with this Consent Judgment, finds and orders as follows:

1. Plaintiff State of Iowa *ex rel.* Thomas J. Miller, Iowa Attorney General, has filed a Petition in Equity against the above-captioned Defendants pursuant to Iowa Code § 714.16, the Iowa Consumer Fraud Act (“CFA”), and this Consent Judgment, which has been approved by all of the above-named Defendants, is intended to resolve this litigation.

2. The Court has jurisdiction of the parties and subject matter.

3. The Court finds that this Consent Judgment should be entered.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, pursuant to Iowa R. Civ. P. 1.1501 *et seq.* and the Iowa Consumer Fraud Act that Defendants, and each of them, and (as applicable) their directors, officers, principals, partners, employees, agents, servants, representatives, subsidiaries, affiliates,

successors, assigns, merged or acquired predecessors, parent or controlling entities, and all other persons, corporations and other entities acting in concert or participating with any one or more Defendants who have actual or constructive notice of the Court's injunction, are permanently restrained and enjoined from engaging in any telemarketing, direct mail marketing, or other marketing of copier or printer toner, other office supplies, or any other merchandise as defined at Iowa Code § 714.16 (1)(i), to individuals, organizations, businesses, libraries, governmental offices, or other entities of whatever nature located in Iowa.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, pursuant to Iowa Code § 714.16, each Defendant shall promptly make a full refund to any Iowan who previously purchased merchandise from such Defendant and requests a refund.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that each Defendant comply, honestly and in good faith, with reasonable requests by the Attorney General for information regarding the activities described in the Petition.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Court retain jurisdiction to enforce this Consent Judgment.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Defendants pay court costs, if any.


