<p>Iowa Homeless Youth Center (Community-Based Organization of YSS) <i>Des Moines</i></p>	<p>Provides comprehensive services to victims of crime including sex trafficking survivors between ages 18 to 21 for males and 18 to 24 for females, including those who are pregnant and parenting. Staff are human trafficking and trauma-informed trained and provide crisis intervention, counseling, emergency beds and transitional living (for up to a maximum of 24 months). They also offer the Youth Opportunity Center located in Des Moines. YSS provides emergency shelter for youth ages 12 to 17 in Ames and Mason City. Transitional living services are available for survivors ages 18 to 21 for a maximum of 24 months. YSS also offers prevention and awareness programming for youth, parents, and community groups.
