Victim of a violent offense committed in Iowa. Including, but not limited to:

- Homicide
- Assault
- Domestic Abuse
- Sexual Assault
- OWI, Hit and Run, Reckless Driving or Boating
- Arson or Burglary of Victim's residence

What

Crime-related Benefits we can consider:

- Medical \$25,000 maximum
- Funeral and burial \$7,500 maximum
- Counseling \$5,000 maximum
- Lost wages due to injuries (physical or emotional) up to \$6,000
- Lost wages to attend criminal court proceedings up to \$1,000
- Crime Scene Clean-up of victim's residence up to \$1,000
- Travel/lodging up to \$1,000
- Emergency Relocation \$1,000 per lifetime
- Residential Security up to \$500
- Clothing held as evidence \$200

What Not

Non-eligible crimes and expenses include:

- Theft, forgery, and other financial crimes, and dog bites
- Auto damages, towing expenses, and attorney fees

When

Now

- Victims can apply immediately after the crime and upto 2 years after the crime date. If beyond 2 years from the crime, please contact the office.
- Criminal charges do NOT have to be filed for eligibility.
