WHO CAN APPLY

Victims Of A Violent Offense Committed In Iowa

Including, but not limited to:

- Homicide
- Assault
- Domestic Abuse
- Sexual Assault
- OWI, Hit And Run, Reckless Driving Or Boating
- Arson Or Burglary Of Victim's Residence

WHAT IS NOT COVERED

Non-Eligible Crimes & Expenses

- Theft
- Forgery And Other Financial Crimes
- Dog Bites
- Auto Damages And Towing Expenses
- Attorney Fees

WHEN TO APPLY

Apply Now — Up To 2 Years After The Crime

- Criminal Charges Do Not Have To Be Filed For Eligibility.
- Victims Can Apply Immediately After The Crime, Up To 2 Years After The Crime Date.
If Beyond 2 Years From The Crime Date, Please Contact Our Office.

WHAT IS COVERED

Benefit Type	Max
Medical care (crime victim)	\$25,000
Medical care (homicide survivor)	\$3,000
Counseling (victim or homicide survivor)	\$5,000
Counseling (secondary victim)	\$2,000
Lost wages (crime-related injury)	\$6,000
Lost wages (homicide survivor)	\$6,000
Lost wages (medical/counseling appts.)	\$1,000
Lost wages (justice system proceedings)	\$1,000
Funeral and burial (homicide)	\$7,500
Crime scene cleanup	\$1,000
Child or dependent adult care	\$1,000
Travel and lodging	\$1,000
Emergency relocation (once per lifetime)	\$1,000
Clothing/bedding held as evidence	\$200
Home security improvements	\$500
